

The majority of crimes that occur in Laguna Hills are property crimes. Criminals are looking for an easy opportunity with the lowest risk; if you provide it, they will take it! In a safe community like ours, it's easy to forget to lock your car, lower your garage, or protect your valuables. These simple preventative steps can go a long way toward eliminating those opportunities and reducing the frequency of burglaries and thefts in our city.

## Home Security

- Always lock your windows and doors when you go out, even if for only a few minutes.
- Keep the landscaping around your home trimmed down around doorways, windows, and light fixtures.
- Never leave a purse, wallet, or other valuables in plain sight.
- Keep your porch light on from dusk to dawn.
- Use several timers to turn on interior lights throughout your home. These timers should be used when you are both on vacation and at home.
- Give the same importance to garage doors as you would your front door. Make sure they are of a solid core construction and have a deadbolt lock.
- At night and when you are away from home, lock the garage door leading into your house.
- All sliding glass doors and windows should be equipped with anti-lift protection.
- To keep your valuables safe, consider using a safety deposit box at your local bank.
- Never leave a house key available under a doormat, in a flowerpot, or on the ledge of a piler.
  - These are the first places a burglar will look!
- If you will be away for several days, have a trusted friend or neighbor pickup your mail and paper.
- Never open your door to strangers. Talk through the door if you do not recognize the person.
- Be aware of people posing as service personnel attempting to gain access to your home.
  - Ask for identification and verify it by calling the company.
- Never let a stranger know you're home alone, whether the person is at your door or on the phone.
- Install security cameras.
- Connect your alarm system to all your home's doors and windows.
- Do not post that you are going on a trip for a period of time on social media.
- Join Neighborhood Watch! The best crime prevention device ever invented is a good neighbor.

## Vehicle Security

- Park in open, well-lit, populated areas. In the neighborhoods, park in the garage or driveway.
  - Park your vehicle directly in front of your house if the garage or driveway is occupied.
- Install a locking fuel cap.
- · Never leave your vehicle running while unattended.
- Do not leave doors unlocked or keys in the vehicle.
- Do not leave valuables in plain view.
- GPS devices, laptops, purses, wallets, cellphones, and chargers.
- Do not leave items with personal information in tour vehicle.
- Do not leave the garage door opener in vehicle.
- If items are being left in your vehicle move them to the trunk.
  - Out of sight, out of mind.
